Toiletpaper is an artists' magazine created by Maurizio Cattelan and Pierpaolo Ferrari, born from a shared obsession with images and their disruptive power. Since 2010, it has functioned as a visual laboratory where simple ideas evolve into meticulously staged photographs. Published three years after issue 20, *Toiletpaper Magazine 21* marks a new chapter, presenting bold, unsettling, and often humorous images where commercial aesthetics collide with surreal distortions, turning the familiar into the uncanny.

Maurizio Cattelan is an Italian contemporary artist known for his provocative and ironic works that challenge the art system and popular culture, and is internationally recognized. Pierpaolo Ferrari is an Italian photographer and creative director whose practice blends fashion, advertising, and surreal imagery, and who, since 2009, has defined the distinctive visual language of *Toiletpaper* together with Maurizio Cattelan.

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
